- ½ yd. - red print for star blocks and appliqué
- 1¼ yd. - brown print for corner blocks, sashing squares, and binding
- ¼ yd. - medium-pink print for appliqué
- Corner Trimmer by Marti Mitchell or Triangle Trimmers by Fons and Porter
- Neutral-color thread
