Discover how surprisingly simple it is to sew perfect curves using turned-edge applqué techniques. Class begins with sewing strip blocks. Then Nancy will shift focus to easy invisible machine appliqué techniques. Vibrant colors always get a boost when paired with black and white. Students will have a dazzling quilt whether they pair black-and-white prints with two colors or twenty. Finished quilt size: 58" x 67".
