Please bring the following items to class:

- **[Basic Sewing Supplies](#)**
- (1) yd. - background fabric A for star feathers and setting pieces
- $\frac{5}{8}$ yd. - fabric B for star feathers
- ($1\frac{1}{8}$) yd. - fabric C for star points, outer border, and binding
- $\frac{3}{8}$ yd. - fabric D for star block center and border blocks
- $\frac{3}{4}$ yd. - fabric E for middle border and border blocks
- $\frac{3}{8}$ yd. - fabric F for inner border
- 6" or smaller square ruler with 45 degree diagonal line
- Plastic baggies to carry precut pieces
