- (5¾) yd. - light fabric for background
- (22) fat quarters (18" x 22") - assorted light, medium, and dark prints for star blocks and yo-yos
- (1) yd. - dark green print for star blocks and appliqué
- ½ yd. - red print for star blocks and appliqué
- (1¼) yd. - brown print for corner blocks, sashing squares, and binding
- ¼ yd. - medium-pink print for appliqué
- Neutral-colored thread
- Corner Trimmer by Marti Michell or Triangle Trimmer by Fons and Porter
