Templates can be used to create a multitude of beautiful designs; they are not just for ditch stitching! This class is geared towards new template users and those seeking more confidence using templates. The class will cover basic patterns created using both a straight template and as a 12" arc template. These patterns include linework and crosshatching. Students will each quilt a sampler quilt using templates and leave with the confidence to work with templates again and again!
