Supplies:

A materials fee is required and includes: printed materials, and use of all the shared and provided supplies that you don't want to go chasing around after.

Materials Fee: \$5 (payable in class)

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- (10-15) - fat quarters (18" x 22"): solids, semisolids, and/or small- to medium-scale prints. Be sure you have value contrast: dark, med, bright, and one solid light to medium light will serve you well. Pick things you like and that look good together, and we will make it work beautifully in class.
- Fabric and paper scissors
- Your favorite invisible monofilament thread in smoke or clear, according to your fabric
- Bobbin thread (like Aurifil) in a neutral color. Avoid very light colors unless your fabric is very light.
- Personal pinnable pressing board
- Straight pins
- Spray starch (Magic® Premium Starch or Sizing in the blue can is Karen's favorite)

Stationary sewing machines are provided by Janome.

Irons are provided by Reliable.

Rotary cutters, mats, and 6" x 24" rulers are provided by Havel's Sewing.

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
