Deb's Galaxy project is a beautiful alternating block design with three different size options. Students will make two types of pieced blocks and put them together like a checkerboard. Careful color placement and different angles created with the V-Block tool result in what seems to be interlocking circles, yet all seams are straight. What a fun optical illusion! Students can expect to complete samples of both the required blocks during class time.

 - Light background fabric
 - (1 $\frac{1}{4}$) yd. for small
 - (2) yd. for medium

- (3 $\frac{1}{8}$) yd. for large
- Backing fabric
 - (3 $\frac{1}{2}$) yd. for small
 - (5) yd. for medium
 - (9 $\frac{3}{4}$) yd. for large
- 6" x 12" ruler
- Neutral-colored thread
- Tucker Trimmer I tool (available for purchase in class - **\$19.50**)
- V Block tool (available for purchase in class - **\$21.50**)
- Quilter's Magic Wand (available for purchase in class - **\$5.50**)
- Pigma pens (available for purchase in class - **\$3.50**)
- Invisi-Grip by Omnigrid®
