Supplies:

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- (1/2-1) yd. each - (2-4) different multicolored bilaterally symmetrical fabrics
- (1) yd. - rich tonal, reads-like-a-solid black print fabric.
- Black thread
- (4) sheets of see-through template plastic with 1/8" grid and bold inch line (Paula prefers Visi-Grid. Available for purchase in class - **\$12**)

Note: "Bilaterally symmetrical" is the property of being divisible into symmetrical halves on either side of a unique plane. These fabrics can be divided into two equal halves. "Reads-like-a-solid" means there is a barely-visible underlying print.

Optional:

- Paula Nadelstern fabric, including bilaterally symmetrical fabric, will be available for purchase in class. - **\$12 per yard**
