Supplies:

A kit is required and includes: Small Town pattern, extra copy of Small Town template for cutting, and workshop notes.

Kit Fee: \$12 (payable in class)

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- (1) yd. - background fabric
- (1) yd. - appliqué fabric (preferably high-count, like a batik)
- Small, sharp embroidery scissors
- Fine appliqué thread to match appliqué fabric
- Appliqué pins
- Fabric glue
- Variety of embroidery floss
- Embroidery needle
- Embroidery hoop

Note: Prep for class - Fold the applique fabric in half (from top to bottom) and then in half again (from left to right) and press gently on the folds. Baste with thread on the pressed folds either by machine or by hand. Repeat this for the background fabric.

Optional:

- Fray Check
- Clover Clips (Available for purchase in class - **\$7.50**)
- Roxanne's Glue Baste-It (Available for purchase in class - **\$16**)
- Embroidery floss in black (Available for purchase in class - **\$0.50**)
- Additional patterns in the Walk in the Park series (Available for purchase in class - **\$12**)
