- (1) ¼ yd. (12", 18", 24" width) or (1) 2" X 12" - Steam-a-Seam 2 or Steam-a-Seam 2 Lite
- (1) fat quarter (18" x 22") or smaller - tearaway stabilizer
- Small, sharp embroidery scissors
- 40 wt. shiny polyester thread for satin stitch
- Reel of strong polyester sewing thread
- 6" x 12" ruler
- Small amount of narrow rickrack
