Supplies:

A kit is required and includes: use of MX procion dyes, eye droppers, squeeze bottles, soda ash, shibori tools, salt, sodium alginate, monofilament, spoons, and containers in class.

- Scissors
- Pen/pencil and notebook
- (12-15) fat quarters (18" x 22") - white 100% cotton prepared for dyeing (PFD) or prewashed fabric
- Dishwashing gloves (the longer, the better)
- (2) extra-large trash bags
- Assorted foam or bristle paintbrushes
