On day two, you'll use your hand-dyed fabrics and Marjan's easy techniques to create a beautiful floral quilt with oversized images. You will choose from (7) original flower drawings provided by the instructor to create your one-of-a-kind quilt. Don't miss your chance to bring your work to life from color to quilt.

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- (5) yd. - Prepared-for-dyeing (PFD) cotton
- (2) yd. - Pellon 805 Wonder Under fusible web
- (20) one-gallon freezer Ziploc® bags
- (3) large trash bags
- Plastic dish pan
- (1) ½ gallon recycled juice or milk jug with lid
- Old set of measuring spoons and 2-cup-size measuring cup (cannot be used for food later)
- (1) roll paper towels
- Rubber gloves
- Apron (it is a good idea to also wear old clothes)
- Foam brushes
- Clothespins and/or rubber bands
