Supplies:

A kit is required and includes: handouts; use of dyes, chemicals, and stamps

Kit Fee: \$15 (payable in class)

Please Bring the following items to class:

- (5) yd. 100% cotton, white prepared for dyeing (PFD) or prewashed fabric
- (1) yd. black, 100% cotton fabric, prewashed
- (20) one-gallon freezer Ziploc® bags
- (3) large trash bags
- Old newspapers (to absorb spills)
- Plastic dish pan
- (1) ½ gallon recycled juice or milk jug with lid
- Old set of measuring spoons and 2-cup-size measuring cup (cannot be used for food later)
- Paper towels
- Rubber gloves
- Apron (it is a good idea to wear old clothes)
- Foam brushes
- Clothespins and/or rubber bands

Optional:

- Silk scarves for dyeing, **\$5.00 each**
- 'Ugly' prints (cotton, prewashed) for overdyeing
- Foam stamps
