Supplies:

A kit is required and includes: Quilt pattern, plastic circle template and blade pattern (already cut), 14" laser-cut shape of white wool felt (backing), (1) skein of embroidery floss - white, (2) hand needles - sharp (for appliquéing), and chenille for embroidery.

Kit Fee: \$18 (payable in class)

Please Bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- (20) 3" X 6" strips of cotton fabric (coordinated or scrappy)
- (1) 3" square of cotton fabric (center of the "plate")
- (1) spool of matching or coordinating 100% cotton thread
- 1" X 6" ruler
- 5" or 6" square acrylic ruler
