What do you do with all those tiny leftover scraps? Be frugal and thrifty by recycling them! Join this totally fun and creative class, and use up the smallest scraps (strips, squares, trimmed triangles, funky sizes, etc.) that you have - the ones you usually throw away! You will learn how to creatively use what you have in front of you! This is stress-free quilting at its finest. You will be piecing (crazily, that is) 4½" squares that can be used in several different ways to make a table runner or wallhanging by adding sashing, an outer border, and binding.

### Supplies:

A handout is required.

**Handout/Pattern Fee:** \$10 (payable in class)

*Please Bring the following items to class:*

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- (1) large spool of 100% cotton thread in medium grey
- 1" x 6" ruler
- 5" or 6" square acrylic ruler
- (1) gallon bag full of all different sizes of scraps - the more the merrier! (Please cut your 100% cotton scraps – any print, solid, strip, plaid, novelties, dots, batiks, neutrals, tonals, etc. - in different colors, scales, and values. Cut the scraps into small shapes and strips with at least ¾" on all sides. Recycle all your fabric leftovers from other projects, fat quarters, Jelly Rolls, etc. – the crazier the shape and size, the better!)
