Are you ready to create a terrific new quilt design that's fast and fun to construct? This striking, original quilt can easily be made from (18) 10" squares (Layer Cake) squares and background fabric (plus a little extra for the arrows). Kimberly used her sumptuous Solid-ish line of fabric to make this version, but eighteen of any 10" squares will work. Choose fabrics from your stash or dive into that special Layer Cake bundle you've been saving. It's easy to construct the arrowheads, and you'll use Kimberly's EZ Flying Geese Ruler and the leftover bits of fabric from each of those squares to make the colorful feathers on the arrows. This technique is super fun and completely stress-free! Come join Kimberly and create a quilt that will be cherished and loved.
