Please Bring the following items to class:

- Basic Sewing Supplies
- (3) 18" square cotton fabric sandwiches fabric top, batting, bakcing. (These can be pin-basted at the edges, or the edges can be zigzagged.)

<u>Note:</u> It is not recommended to thread baste. The back of the sandwich can be any cotton quilting fabric, and the top should be a solid.

Stationary sewing machines are provided by BERNINA. Irons are provided by Reliable. Rotary cutters, mats, and 6" x 24" rulers are provided by AccuQuilt®.
