This class will cover materials and tools, straight-line quilting and free-motion techniques, and strategies for handling and quilting larger quilts on a home sewing machine. Day one will cover set-up and fundamentals like loading your quilt and warming up your body for quilting basic designs. The second day covers deciding what to quilt where, developing a detailed quilting plan, and building a vocabulary of machine quilting movements and designs. You'll leave this two-day workshop with the confidence to quilt on your machine at home!
