#### **Supplies:**

A kit is required and includes: color photographic instructions, ink pencils, textile medium, paint brushes, fabric marker, water-soluble glue stick, paint cups, uncoated paper plate, freezer paper, master pattern, master pattern drawn on "prepared for dyeing" (PFD) cotton fabric and ironed on freezer paper for stabilization, and more. There will be enough supplies left over for you to make several painted wholecloth quilts in the future.

**Kit Fee: \$35** (payable in class)

*Please bring the following items to class:*

- (1) 8" x 10" piece - non-corrugated cardboard, foam core, or poster board
- Pre-moistened washcloth inside a baggie to keep fingers clean
- (6) paper towels
- Plastic container with water for cleaning paint brushes
- Two-hole pencil sharpener
- Non scented baby wipes
