### Supplies:

*Please bring the following items to class:*

- (1) gallon ziplock bag full - 5" square or larger pieces of non-busy fabric. Bring light, medium, and dark values of all colors including white, gray, black, and cream. (Stonehenge and Moda Marbles are both examples of non-busy fabrics. You can also bring solid fabrics. We will be cutting and pasting the fabric, so bring many different colors and values.)
- Fabric scissors
- Paper scissors
- 6" square ruler
- Glue stick
- Colored pencils or crayons
