Templates can be used to create a multitude of beautiful designs; they are not just for ditch stitching! This class is geared towards new template users and those seeking more confidence in using templates. The class will cover basic patterns created using both a straight template and a 12" arc template. These patterns include linework and crosshatching. Students will each quilt a sampler quilt using templates and leave with the confidence to work with templates again and again!

### Supplies:

A kit is required and includes: backing, batting, sampler top, handouts and instructions, 4" circle longarm template.

**Kit Fee: \$25** (payable in class)

*Please bring the following items to class:*

- 1/4" thick longarm straight template with several etched 1/4" spaced lines
- 1/4" thick longarm template with 12" diameter for crosshatching (must be like the Boomerang sold by Deloa Jones and must have etched 1/4" spaced curved lines)
- New air or water erasable fabric marking pen
- Fabric scissors
- Pen and pencil
- Notebook
