In this workshop, students will learn how to create beautiful window boxes using a basic Courthouse Steps block. The pattern was created by Lenore's mother, Myra Moore, and is a unique design using floral prints as the flowers for the window box. Students will create Courthouse Steps blocks, then sew them together to create a finished art quilt. They can be configured three in a row, four in a square, or even three stacked vertically. Create as many as you like! Students can take their design home and finish putting it together with batting, backing, and borders. This full-day class includes show admission for Friday.

- At least (30) 1½" x 12" strips - a variety of bright-colored textural print fabrics like reds, oranges, blues, magentas, and yellows (not solids)
- At least (30) 1½" x 12" strips total - variety of floral prints
- 12" ruler
