**Supplies:**

*Please bring the following items to class:*

- At least 100 - 2 ½" squares - include lots of choices in value and color
  - use fabrics of all colors and all fiber contents (tone-on-tone works best)
  - There will be a prize for the one who brings the most fabric squares
- Fabric scissors
- Paper scissors
- Straight pins
- Glue stick
- 20" square solid white fabric to use as a pin-up surface (muslin, batting, felt, flannel, etc.)
