Supplies:

A kit is required and includes: foundation paper that stays in the quilt, reusable paper piecing stencil, color handout, and custom acrylic templates.

Kit Fee: \$28 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- (5) 8" squares - beige fabric (sand)
- (30) 3" X 4" rectangles - beige fabric (sand)
- (25) 2½" X 3½" rectangles - cream/white (waves)
- (5) 4½" squares - light/medium teal (ocean)
- 9½" square ruler with bias line (Omnigrid® is suggested)
- Neutral-colored piecing thread
- Small baggie for cutaways
- Pigma® Brush pen, available to purchase in class, **\$3**

NOTE: Linda likes to starch her fabric before cutting, but it is not a requirement.
