Precutting Instructions

EZFG = *EZ Flying Geese Ruler*

RST = right-sides together

HST = half-square triangle

EZJR = *EZ Jelly Roll Ruler*

WOF = width of fabric

FABRIC #	COLOR/ VALUE	YARDAGE	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
1	Multicolor, main print (Blocks and optional outer border)	$\frac{7}{8}$ yard (no border) OR $1\frac{5}{8}$ yards (with border)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$" strip (if using the EZFG method for HSTs) OR cut (1) $4\frac{7}{8}$" strip. [Clue 1] • Cut (1) $8\frac{7}{8}$" strip; cut (4) $8\frac{7}{8}$" squares. Cut squares 1x diagonally to yield (8) triangles. [Clue 3] • Cut (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$" strip; cut (8) $4\frac{1}{2}$" squares. [Clue 5] • (1) $8\frac{1}{2}$" strip; cut (4) $8\frac{1}{2}$" squares. [Clue 6] • Cut (6) $4\frac{1}{2}$" strips; piece together for <i>optional</i> outer border. [Clue 6]
2	LIGHT background	$\frac{7}{8}$ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut (1) $8\frac{7}{8}$" strip; cut (4) $8\frac{7}{8}$" squares. Pair with fabric #6. [Clue 2] • Cut (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$" strips. Pair with fabric #5 strips. [Clue 3] • Cut (1) $8\frac{1}{2}$" strip; cut (4) $8\frac{1}{2}$" squares. [Clue 6]
3	MEDIUM LIGHT	$\frac{3}{8}$ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$" strip (if using the EZFG method for HSTs) OR cut (1) $4\frac{7}{8}$" strip. [Clue 1] • Cut (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$" strip. [Clue 4]
4	MEDIUM	$\frac{3}{8}$ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$" strips. Pair with fabric #5 strips. [Clue 4] • Cut (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$" strip; subcut (4) $4\frac{1}{2}$" squares. [Clue 5]
5	MEDIUM	$\frac{1}{2}$ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$" strips. Pair with fabric #2 strips. [Clue 3] • Cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$" strips. Pair with fabric #4 strips. [Clue 4]
6	DARK	$\frac{3}{4}$ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$" strip (if using the EZFG method for HSTs) OR cut (1) $4\frac{7}{8}$" strip. [Clue 1] NOTE: <i>If you are using the traditional method, you may need 2 strips.</i> • Cut (1) $8\frac{7}{8}$" strip; cut (4) $8\frac{7}{8}$" squares. Pair with fabric #2. [Clue 2] • Cut (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$" strip. [Clue 4]

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Supplies to Finish Project at Home - NOT Needed for Class:

FABRIC #	COLOR/ VALUE	YARDAGE	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
Binding		½ yard	• Cut (7) 2¼" strips for binding.
Batting		64" x 64"	
Backing		2 panels 32" x 64"	

- **To get a head start on completing this quilt and to make the best use of your class time, please complete Clues #1 and #2 at home prior to coming to class. This is optional.**
- Create a legend of your fabrics on the fabric cutting chart. Attach a small piece of each fabric in the square next to the corresponding fabric number. You'll be very glad you took the time to do this!
- Cut your fabrics as directed below prior to class. (*Cut all strips across the WOF, selvage to selvage.*) To keep all your cut strips and fabric pieces organized put them in Ziplock® baggies by clue numbers, and label with the fabric numbers.
- Bring all fabrics and leftover pieces to class!

CLUE 1

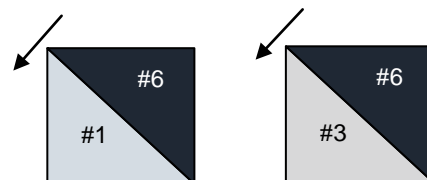
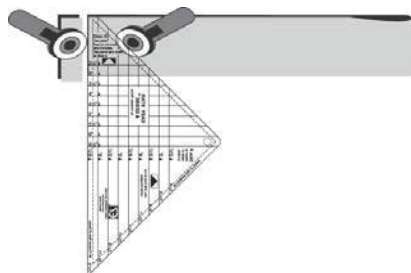
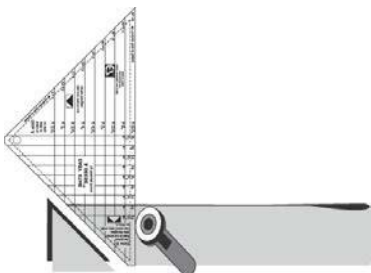
Choose Kimberly's ***EZ Flying Geese Ruler*** method **OR** the traditional method and cut your strips as outlined in the Cutting Chart above.

Here's what you'll make:

- (8) 4½" (unfinished) HSTs from fabrics #1 and #6.
- (8) 4½" (unfinished) HSTs from fabrics #3 and #6.

EZ Flying Geese Ruler method:

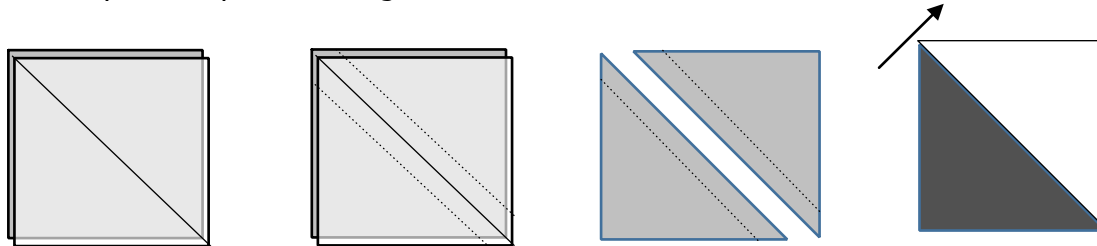
- Place (1) 4½" strip each of fabrics #1 and #6 RST.
- Use Side B of the ***EZ Flying Geese Ruler*** to cut (8) 4½" triangle pairs (16 triangles total) for HSTs.
- Chain stitch the units together on the long edge of the triangles.
- Press the seams away from fabric #6.
- Units should measure 4½" x 4½" (unfinished).
Trim the dog ears and square-up if necessary. **Make 8.**
- Repeat the process using fabric #3 and the remaining (or second) strip of #6. **Make 8.**



Make 8 of each.

Traditional method:

- Cut (4) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares each of fabrics #1 and #6 and pair one of each square RST.
- Draw a diagonal line on the back of the fabric #1 square and stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the diagonal line.
- Cut on the drawn line.
- Press the seams away from fabric #6.
- The HSTs should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " (unfinished).
Trim the dog ears and square-up if necessary. **Make 8.**
- Repeat the process using fabrics #3 and #6. **Make 8.**



CLUE 2

- Place (4) $8\frac{7}{8}$ " squares each of fabrics #2 and #6 RST.
- Draw a diagonal line on the back of the fabric #2 square and stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the diagonal line.
- Cut on the drawn line.
- Press the seams toward fabric #6.
- The HSTs should measure $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " (unfinished).
Trim the dog ears and square-up if necessary. **Make 8.**
