Supplies:

A kit is required and includes: cotton fabric, plus use of discharge supplies, dye and chemicals, detergent, gloves, dust mask, and other tools needed to complete class.

Kit Fee: \$75 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- Comfortable art clothes and shoes
- (2) Plastic tote bins with lid approximately 23" x 17" x 6"
- Sharpie® permanent marker
- Roll of paper towels or shop rags
- Can of temporary spray adhesive (Cindy likes 505, but any brand that is odorless, colorless, non-staining, and acid-free will work)
- Roll of freezer paper. Precut several pieces of each of the following sizes: 10" x 14", 14" square, and 20" x 24"
- (2) sheets of Tyvek® paper or (1) USPS priority envelope
- Safety pins

NOTE: Cindy will bring her library of stencils and foam stamps, but if you have any you would like to bring to play with, please bring them! (Rubber stamps tend to be too fine-lined for this technique.)

Irons are provided by Reliable.

Rotary cutters, mats, and 6" x 24" rulers are provided by AccuQuilt®.
