Ombré / ' ombrei/ (literally "shaded" in French) is the gradual blending of one color hue to another, usually moving tints and shades from light to dark. No more bending and twisting, dip dyeing, and hoping to achieve the gradual changes characteristic to ombré fabrics. Learn this fun and easy way to create subtle value shifts from light to dark, or to explore the range of color created when blending two colors together. Using 18"x 44" half-yard pieces of fabric, this is a DYE ALL THE FABRIC YOU CAN class! Join the fun and expand your knowledge of fabric dyeing and color in this highly creative class.
