Supplies:

A kit is required and includes: (3) yd. high quality prepared-for-dyeing fabric, all dye, fixatives, detergents, gloves, dust mask, and a reusable toolkit that includes an extensive set of acrylic specialty templates, mixing cups and utensils, funnels, squeeze bottles, and full color instructions.

Kit Fee: \$90 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- Paper scissors
- Straight pins
- Art clothes or apron and comfortable shoes
- (1) plastic tote bin and lid - approximately 24" x 18" x 6"
- Craft scissors
- Permanent marker
- (1) large plastic bag (lawn & garden size)
- Roll of paper towels
- At least (10 - 12) 4" spring clamps and (4) 6" spring clamps - plastic works best. The more clamps you have, the more creative freedom you have.
