A kit is required and includes: 12" sq. muslin base, (12) fancy fabrics, (2) hand-dyed lace, (9) silk and perle embroidery threads, (3) variegated threads, (3) metallic threads, (2) satin ribbons, (2) sheer ribbons, (2) trims, (8) 4mm silk ribbons, (2) 7mm silk ribbons, (2) 18" wire ribbons, bead bag including beads, (4) needles, (4) doodads, (4) buttons, (2) yd. NYMO thread, and pattern/diagram.
