A kit is required and includes: pattern and acrylic template

Kit Fee: \$37 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- (5) fat quarters (18" x 22") - bright prints
- (5) fat quarters (18" x 22") - bright solids
- Fabric scissors
- Straight pins
- Thread to match fabrics
- 6" x 12" ruler

Notes:

- Yardage based on the 66" X 84" quilt layout pictured above, with a solid fabric paired with a print fabric. Please use this as a planning guide for your quilt.
- Additional ideas for prints to bring: stripes, large-scale prints, ombré (light to dark prints), prints with interesting elements for fussy cutting, etc.

To make the entire quilt: (23) fat quarters (18" x 22") - bright prints or 5½ yd. total and (23) fat quarters (18" x 22") - bright solids or 5½ yd. total.

Stationary sewing machines are provided by Juki.

Irons are provided by Reliable.

Rotary cutters, mats, and 6" x 24" rulers are provided by AccuQuilt®.

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
