REQUIRED KIT: \$28.00

Includes full color handout, custom acrylic templates, re-useable foundation piecing stencil and foundation paper for the project that can be left in the quilt (no more ripping out!)



GENERAL SUPPLIES:

Pigma Brush Tip Pen preferably in a color coordinating with your fabrics
- I will have a limited supply of Black (\$3) in class

9-1/2" square ruler - I use Omnigridd 9-1/2" square

Neutral color thread for piecing

General quilting supplies - scissors, rotary cutter, small mat, straight pins

Optional—60" square batting - to use as design surface and also to pin your pieces to for easy transport home

Caramels might be nice ;-)

PINK - **557 Azalea** - 1/2 yard
(2) 5" x 5" squares
(2) 6-1/2" squares cut in half on diagonal
(4) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles
(12) 4-1/2" squares

PURPLE - **276 Sea Urchin** - 1 yard
(2) 5" x 5" squares
(2) 6-1/2" squares cut in half on diagonal
(4) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles
(5) 2-1/2" x WOF (Binding)

BLUE - **136 Peacock** - 1 yard
(12) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles
(12) 5" x 5"
(2) 6-1/2" on diagonal

DARKER BLUE - **361 Cabo** - 1 yard
(12) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles
(12) 5" x 5"
(2) 6-1/2" on diagonal

ORANGE - **277 Koi** - 5/8 yard
(8) 4-1/2" squares
(60) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles

BORDER - **884-135 Pastel** - 1 yard
(40) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles
(2) 4" x 40-1/2" strips
(2) 4" x 48-1/2" strips

BACKGROUND - **Q2-167-443 Sea Salt** - 2 & 1/2 yards
(120) 3" x 4" rectangles
(20) 8" squares
(8) 5" x 5" squares

BACKING - 3 & 1/3 yards
(2) cuts of 40" x 56" seamed vertically—includes enough for long arm quilting and matching hanging sleeve

***MY SAMPLE QUILT WAS MADE USING HOFFMAN 1895 BATIKS** I have provided you with the color number and name of the specific fabric that I used.*

In class I will show you how to make a miniature quilt using the scraps and cutaways from this quilt. Your choice of layout will depend on how much extra fabric you have left, so you may wish to purchase a little over if interested.
