Supplies:

A kit is required and includes: foundation paper that can be left in the quilt, reusable foundation piecing stencil, and custom acrylic templates.

Kit Fee: \$28 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- (4) 4½" squares - all same color (centers)
- (20) 2½" X 3½" rectangles - black (spires)
- (24) 3" X 4" rectangles - white (background spires)
- (2) 9" squares - white-on-black (both squares the same fabric)
- (2) 9" squares - black-on-white (both squares the same fabric)
- Fabric scissors
- Paper scissors
- Straight pins
- 8½" or 9½" square ruler with diagonal line (9½" Omingrid® recommended)
- Neutral-colored thread
- Pigma® brush tip pen, available to purchase in class, **\$3**

Note: Please heavily starch your fabrics

Optional Kit/Item Fee: You may preorder a black-and-white/white-and-black fabric package (some fabric may be duplicated) by August 9, 2019 directly from Linda at froghollowdesigns.com while supplies last.
