Piecing the Jack's Chain Block**

Rock Around the Block is based on the traditional Jack's Chain block. Nancy worked out the math so that students do not have to sew any Y seams! She will guide students through each simple step as they create their block. By adding an additional triangle in the four corners of each block, plus sashing and cornerstone units, you can create a secondary block, or you can leave them out and those little Nine-Patches will just keep going around. If you use a black background, they seem to float all over the quilt!

A kit is required and includes: pattern, template, and handout.

Kit Fee: \$12 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- (6) fat quarters (18" x 22") - fabric for Nine-Patches
- (3) yd. - background fabric
- 12½" square ruler
- Neutral-colored thread

For precutting instructions, click here. Precutting must be done before class, as there will not be class time available for cutting.

Optional:

- (1) fat quarter (18" x 22") - red or preferred color for triangles/cornerstones

For the complete quilt, you will need: (9) ⅛ yd. - different-colored fabrics, 4¼ yd. - fabric for background, border, and binding, and (3) yd. - backing fabric.

Stationary sewing machines are provided by Janome.

Irons are provided by Reliable.

Rotary cutters, mats, and 6" x 24" rulers are provided by AccuQuilt®.
