Learn how to take Half Square Triangles, slice and dice, and switcheroo to create these unique stars. Along with learning how to create the stars, there is a special trick to create the 16-patch found in the middle of the star block. This is all done using 10" square bundle of dark to medium color fabrics and yardage for background or light colored fabric. Join Nancy for the evening and make these fun and beautiful stars.

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- 2½ yd. - white fabric cut into the following:
 - (24) 10" squares
 - (32) 2" X 6½" rectangles
 - (32) 2" squares
 - (32) 2" X 3½" rectangles
 - (4) 6½" squares
- (24) 10" squares - assortment medium to dark fabrics
- (32) 2" squares - assortment medium to dark fabrics
- 6½" square ruler
- Thread snips

Precutting:

- 1) Draw a diagonal line on each 10" white square
- 2) Match each 10" white square to a 10" medium or dark square, right sides together
- 3) Sew a ¼" seam on both sides of the drawn diagonal line and cut apart on line
- 4) Press seams open

Stationary sewing machines are provided by Janome.

Irons are provided by Reliable.

Rotary cutters, mats, and 6" x 24" rulers are provided by AccuQuilt®.
