- (4) 15" square solid cotton quilt sandwiches (top/batting/backing), pinned or spray-basted (no prints)
 - use cotton or wool batting
- 50 wt. cotton thread (preferably Aurifil® or Superior®)
- Medium-colored thread
- Several small safety pins
- Blue washout marker
- Quilter's gloves, rubber fingertips, or non-greasy hand cream (i.e. Neutrogena®)

Optional Items:

- Grid stencil - available to purchase in class, **\$9.50**
- Slider Teflon® mat - available to purchase in class, **\$35**
