Supplies:

A kit is required and includes: (12) hand-dyed fabrics, handout with all pattern pieces, and instructions on how to finish your quilt at home.

Kit Fee: \$35 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- ½ yd. - background fabric
- (2) yd. - Steam-A-Seam 2® (available for purchase in class, **\$5**)
- 21" x 27" Teflon® pressing sheet (Ex. Fat Goddess by Mistyfuse®) or parchment paper to cover the size of your flower
- Paper bag for trash
- Large and small sharp scissors for paper and fabric
- (1) box - large-head straight pins
- Stiletto or tweezers
- Glue stick

Irons are provided by Reliable.

Rotary cutters, mats, and 6" x 24" rulers are provided by AccuQuilt®.
