Machine embroidery adds personality to your quilts and needlework. The stitches you choose affect the emotion and atmosphere of your work. In this workshop, you will make a simple sampler using a repeated leaf appliqué, but by changing the finishing embroidery stitches, each leaf takes on different personalities and attitudes. Sample some stitches you have never tried before and try to find the stitches which speak your language to make your needle projects more expressive. You'll learn all about machine embroidery and leave with something beautiful.

Please bring the following items to class:

- [Basic Sewing Supplies](#)
- 19" X 24" fabric - background
- ½ yd. cotton fabric - any color of solid or simple print for leaves
- (1) fat quarter (18" x 22") - stems
- (1) yd. Pellon® ShirTailor® iron-on interfacing
- (1) yd. Wonder-Under or other paper-backed fusible web
- Small, sharp embroidery scissors
- Basic 50 wt. sewing threads to contrast with leaf and stem fabrics
