Pattern Fee: \$10 (payable in class)

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- Prewashed fabrics in complimentary colors precut to no less than 6" square (scraps are perfect!)
 - (1) - dark fabric square
 - (4) - light fabric squares: (2) each - (2) fabrics
 - (12) - medium-to-dark fabric squares.
 - (4) must be of the same fabric
 - The other (8) can be scrappy
- 6" square ruler, with 45-degree angle marked
