- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- (1) yd. - light background fabric
- 1/2 yd. - outer border and middle star fabric (directional fabrics such as stripes work well)
- 1/8 yd. - inner border fabric
- 1/3 yd. - Flying Geese fabric; you may use several different fabrics
- 1/4 yd. - dark fabric for star point
- 6" square or 12" square ruler
- Add-A-Quarter™ Ruler
- Mechanical pencil
- Good eraser
- Freezer paper
