A materials fee is required and includes: pattern, plus use of iron-erase chalk, Roxanne Glue-Baste-It, Hera marker, binding clips, and Petite Leaves Galore template in class. (If students choose to purchase templates after class, the materials fee will be applied to template cost.)

Please bring the following items to class:

- (1) 12" x 18" piece - cork for background
- (1) 3" x 12" piece - cork in an accent color
- (1) 9" x 12" piece - cork in a different accent color
- Thread to match cork fabrics
- 28mm rotary cutter with a sharp blade (available to purchase in class - **\$16.95**)
- Pencil and pen
- Fabric scissors
