

TRANSPORTATION & PARKING



PARKING:

Show guests are encouraged to park in the city lots in downtown Paducah.

Recently these city lots have not been full during AQS QuiltWeek. Free parking is available in the downtown city lots. In addition, there is paid parking on 4th Street between Harrison and Executive Blvd.

SHUTTLE SERVICE:

The AQS Shuttle Stop is located next to the Carroll Convention Center; look for the AQS Shuttle Stop sign. Free shuttle service is provided by participating hotels/motels, participating attractions, the Paducah Convention and Visitors Bureau, and AQS. See the schedules on **PAGES 104-105**. AQS route signs are displayed in the bus windows—be sure to note the color associated with your bus route. The buses can stop only at the participating sites listed on the maps. Anchor Transportation Group is providing the shuttle service this year. The number of buses that stop at each location depends on how many buses the location has contracted for; if the ridership is heavy, please be patient until another bus comes. Paducah Area Transit System (PATS) and the Paducah Convention and Visitors Bureau are providing the free downtown trolleys. Fairfield Inn and Candlewood Suites are providing a van to transport their guests; check at their front desk if you need transportation.

Call PATS at 270-444-8700 to arrange airport pickup (24-hour advance reservation required), accessible service, or transportation to area restaurants. Paducah is also serviced by Blue Dot Cab Company (270-245-1234), Lyft Inc. (lyft.com), and Uber (uber.com).

AQS is providing two shuttles from the Schroeder Expo Center to/from the Dome Pavilion; one of these buses will also stop at the Paducah School of Art and Design, where the International Miniature Quilt Exchange exhibit is displayed in the Bill Ford Gallery, and painting and dyeing classes are being held in the Textile Lab.

FREE TROLLEY:

The Paducah trolley provides free rides through downtown, past the Quilt Museum, and back to the AQS Shuttle Stop. Want to catch a trolley? Just look for the Trolley Stop signs downtown or hop on at the AQS Shuttle Stop. The Paducah-McCracken Convention & Visitors Bureau and PATS provide this service. **Park in the 2nd & Jefferson Street lot or the Farmer's Market lot and meet the trolley at the AQS Trolley Stop signs.**

FREE PARK & RIDE:

Ride the Attractions Shuttle to free parking at Kentucky Oaks Mall (Best Buy end of lot). See the Attractions Shuttle Schedule on **PAGE 105**.

THE NATIONAL QUILT MUSEUM VAN:

The National Quilt Museum (NQM) will have a van for transportation from the AQS Shuttle Stop at the Convention Center to NQM. The van will run from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and will stop at the two parking lots on 2nd Street. Look for the AQS Trolley Stop Signs in the 2nd Street parking lots.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION AT I-24, EXIT 4:
