Linda will also show you how you can create a miniature quilt using the scraps and cutaways of this project quilt.

### **Supplies:**

A kit is required and includes: reusable paper piecing stencil, custom acrylic templates, foundation paper, and color handout.

**Kit Fee: \$17** (payable in class, cash preferred)

*Please bring the following items to class:*

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- 1/2 yd. - aqua fabric
- 1/4 yd. - lime green fabric
- (1 1/3) yd. - white fabric
- 1/2 yd. - blue #1 fabric
- 1/3 yd. - blue #2 fabric
- Neutral-colored thread
- Pigma® Brush pen (available for purchase in class - **\$3**)
- 9 1/2" square ruler (Linda uses Omnigridd®)

**For precutting instructions, click here.** Precutting must be done before class, as there will not be class time available for cutting.

NOTE: Bring fabric to class precut and in baggies. Linda likes to starch her fabric before cutting, but it is not a requirement.

Irons are provided by Reliable.

Rotary cutters, mats, and 6" x 24" rulers are provided by AccuQuilt®.

Stationary sewing machines are provided by Janome.
