Barn quilts are a quilt block painted on wood and hung on barns. They reflect the family's heritage and celebrate the women's role in agriculture through the beautiful quilt blocks they created. Barn quilts can bring that history directly into our homes and can be displayed proudly in a family room, a kitchen, or a backyard gathering place. Katie will walk you through creating your own unique barn quilt on a wooden pallet square! The class will offer several different patterns to choose from and many different paint colors from Fusion Mineral Paint. Come relax and paint with your quilting friends!
