Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- ½ yd. - background fabric (Judi suggests solid or reads-as-solid)
- Scraps - patterned fabric that will be cut into various lengths between 1" x 2½" and 1" x 4½" (Jelly Roll leftovers are good, too)
- 6" x 12" ruler
- Thread to match fabrics
