A handout is required for this class.

Handout Fee: \$4 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- (4) 14" OR 16" square mini quilts ready for binding. This can be a block or just fabric squares or scraps you sew together. You will be binding them in class.
- (6) fat quarters (18" x 22") - coordinating fabrics to make bindings in class. This should complement your 14" or 16" square samples.
- (1) 10" x 24" quilt sandwich
- 1/2 yd. - fabric to make binding in class. This should complement your 10" x 24" sandwich.
- (1) package - Jumbo rickrack to match one of your 14" or 16" squares
- Thread snips
- Sharp fabric scissors
- Thread to match all your fabrics

Rotary cutters, mats, and 6" x 24" rulers are provided by AccuQuilt®.
