A handout is required for this class.

Handout Fee: \$4 (payable in class, cash preferred)

Please bring the following items to class:

- **Basic Sewing Supplies**
- (1) gallon bag full of selvage fabric strips or a mix of selvage strips and 2" strips in fun fabrics
- (1) yd. - fabric for lining
- ½ yd. - fabric for handles, binding, and pocket (pick something that goes with your strips)
- (2) 18" - square pieces - 100% cotton batting
- (1) 6" x 54" piece - 100% cotton batting
- (2) 4" x 30" pieces - 100% cotton batting
- (2) yd. - heavyweight fusible interfacing (shirt tailor weight)
- Neutral-colored thread
- Thread to match fabric
- Large dressmaker-style scissors
- 8" ruler
- (2) packages - premade piping in a color to coordinate with your fabrics
- (1) sheet - plastic needlepoint canvas for tote bag bottom
- 7" regular zipper
- (1) large button (larger than 1")

Irons are provided by Reliable.

Rotary cutters, mats, and 6" x 24" rulers are provided by AccuQuilt®.

Stationary sewing machines are provided by Elna.

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
